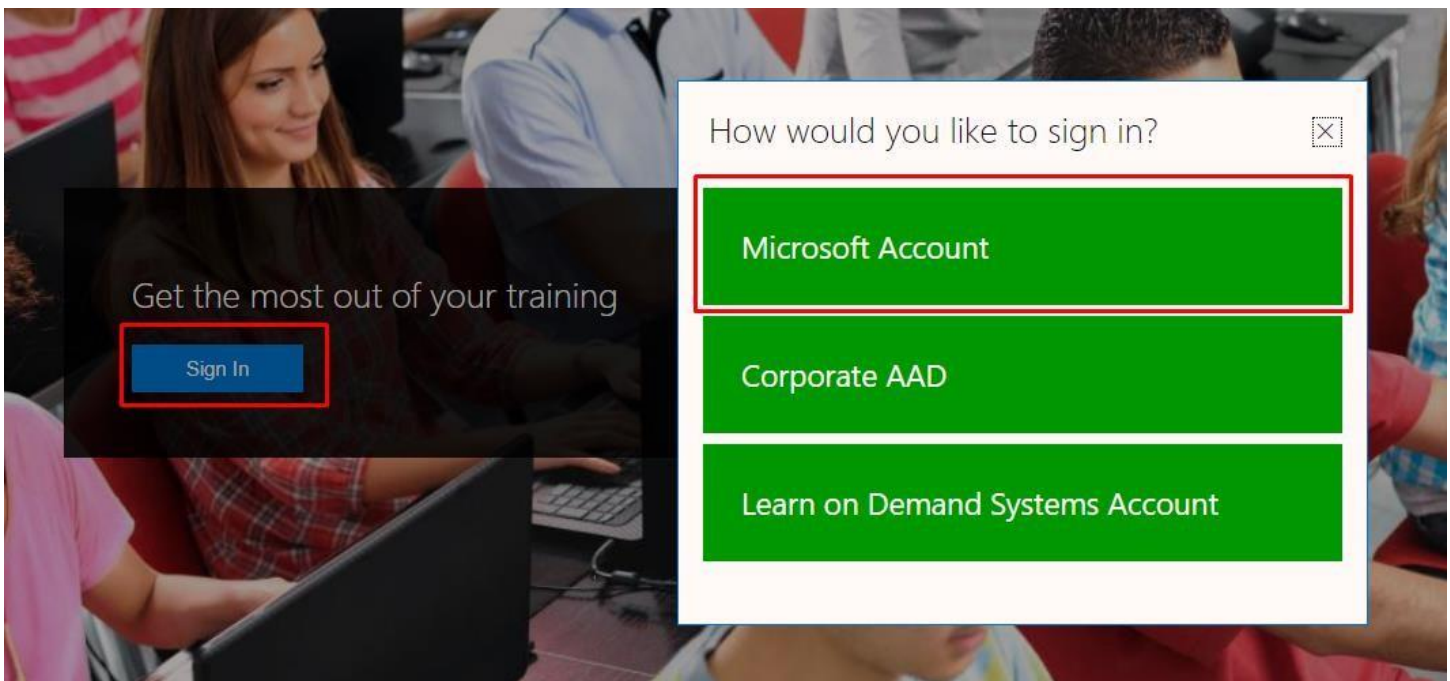
For students to access their class through the Global Systems Integrator Portal hosted by Learn on Demand Systems, they will follow the below steps:

To Access the FSI Portal:

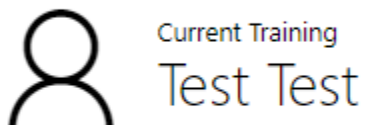
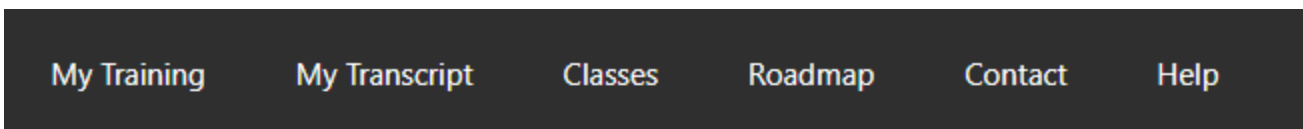
In an HTML5 complaint browser, navigate to <https://gsi.learnondemand.net/>

Select **Sign in** and then select **Microsoft Account**:

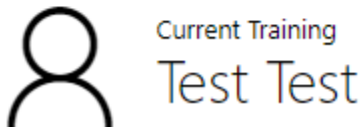
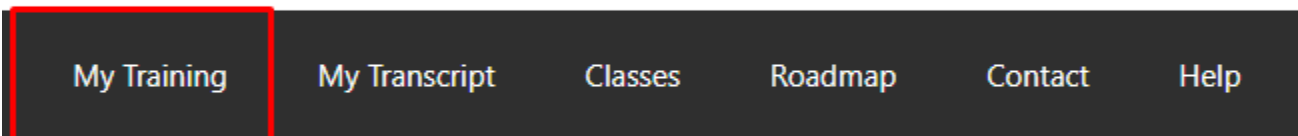


Once logged in, select **Redeem Training Key** from the middle navigation ribbon, and enter the provided training key:

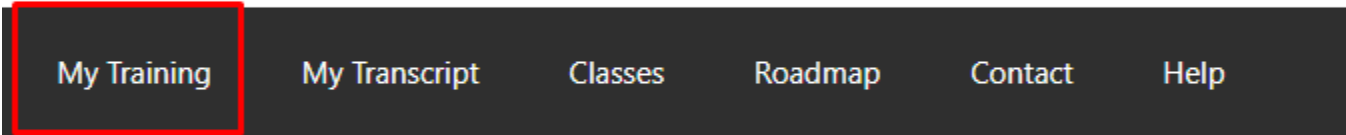

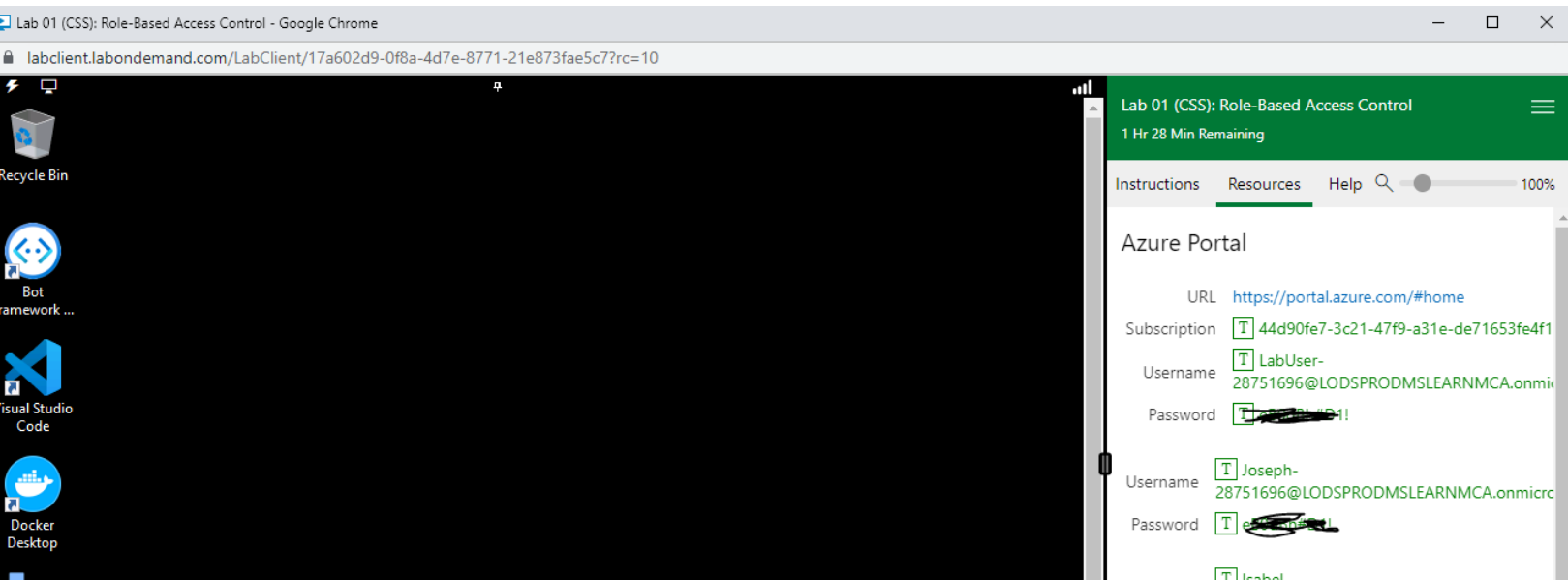

Cloud Slice - Microsoft Azure Setup

Once LODS keys redeemed, Navigate and Launch anyone of the LAB from the LODS environment(Sandbox) and Navigate to Resources and Copy the user and password and login with Portal.Azure.Com



When the Subscription is enabled for Cloud Slice, Skillable Studio is provided with the following access

- Global administrator on the tenant
- Owner of the Subscription
- Subscription is enabled for the all resource providers

To minimize risk, Skillable strongly recommends that

- This tenant is dedicated to only Skillable Studio Cloud Slice labs. Do not use a tenant that you also use for any other purposes.
- You configure External collaboration settings in your dedicated Azure tenant such that Guest user access is highly restricted and that invitations can be sent only to a pre-approved list of external domains (or none at all). You can find these settings in the Azure portal by navigating to Default Directory | Users > Users | User Settings > External collaboration settings.

IMPORTANT: If you restrict invitation to external domains, please ensure you allow invitations to the skillable.com and learnondemandsystems.com domains.

- One or More Azure Subscriptions
- It is highly recommended these subscriptions are dedicated to only Skillable Studio cloud slice labs.
 - While only one subscription is needed to get started, it is recommended to use a group of subscriptions (otherwise known as a "pool") to provide load balancing across them
- To aid in cost isolation, it is helpful to separate subscriptions for different purposes. Within Microsoft Azure, it is helpful to segregate these subscriptions within Management Groups.
